WHAT IS FRAGILE X?

Fragile X is a family of inherited conditions, all caused by changes in the (FMR-1) gene. These conditions include:

- Fragile X Syndrome (FXS), the most common cause of inherited mental impairment. This can range from learning disabilities to more significant cognitive disabilities.
- Fragile X-Associated Tremor Ataxia Syndrome (FXTAS), a condition which affects balance, tremor and memory in some gene carriers (usually older males).
- Fragile X-Associated Primary Ovarian Insufficiency (FXPOI), a problem with ovarian function which can lead to infertility and early menopause in some female gene carriers.
