

# **Summer Scholar Research Awards**

Funded by the National Fragile X Foundation

## 2019 Request for Applications

The National Fragile X Foundation will fund one or more summer student's research at \$2,500 each. The student's work can be in the area of fragile X syndrome (FXS), fragile X-associated tremor/ataxia syndrome (FXTAS) or fragile X-associated primary ovarian insufficiency (FXPOI).

This award is meant to introduce undergraduate students or students in professional training programs to research in the Fragile X field by providing funding for a summer project. It is not meant to supplement funds for PhD candidates or post-doctoral fellows working on research related to Fragile X.

Notification of awards will be made by the end of April 2019.

### Applications should be in the following format:

#### **SECTION A** (Maximum 1 page)

- 1. Short title of proposed project
- 2. Candidate's name
- 3. Candidate's email address and phone number
- 4. Candidate's current educational level
- 5. Candidate's Dept. and University including mailing address
- 6. Dept. and University where project would take place (if different) including mailing address
- 7. Supervisor's Name and title
- 8. Supervisor's email address

#### **SECTION B** (Maximum 3 pages)

- 1. Introduction to proposal
- 2. Aims and hypothesis
- 3. Methods (participants, procedure, materials)
- 4. Timeframe
- 5. Expected Outcomes and relevance to Fragile X

#### **SECTION C**

- 1. The applicant's one-page CV including any relevant experience
- 2. The supervisor's brief bio-sketch
- 3. Three recent publications from the supervisor that relate to Fragile X (List publication's title and provide web links *or* attach the actual publication)
- The applicant can be either an undergraduate or graduate student, and the supervisor should be experienced in research concerning Fragile X.
- The research proposal should state how the project will expand our knowledge of Fragile X and how the research will provide a distinctive training experience.
- All awardees will be required to write a brief description of their experience for possible publication by the National Fragile X Foundation.

The application, including the email, must be submitted by the student.

- In the body of the email please state your name, email address, supervisor, institution where the project will take place and the title of the project.
- All applications must be submitted as an attached PDF. Section A and Section B content should use a standard 12-point font such as Times New Roman, Arial or Calibri and be single-spaced.
- Note: It is the policy of the National Fragile X Foundation that due to the nature of this award and the limited amount of funding, **no Indirect Costs to the institution are allowed.**
