Advocacy Accomplishments

A History of Success

Over \$650 M in Fragile X research between the National Institutes of Health (NIH), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and the Department of Defense (DOD).

- CDC: \$2M/year which funds the FORWARD research program.
- NIH: \$104 Min active awards specific to FMR1-related conditions and disorders.
- Over \$21 M in grants through the Department of Defense (DOD) program since 2010

FRAGILE X INCLUDED IN THE PRMRP LIST FOR FY25

FY25 funding for the CDMRP PRMRP program with the Department of Defense (DOD) was included in the Continuing Resolution (CR) passed on March 14, 2025. The DOD Appropriations Bill report language lists Fragile X as an authorized topic area.

We are awaiting the Program Funding Opportunities applications to be announced. We will share more information as it becomes available.

It is because of your efforts on Capitol Hill, advocating with your Members of Congress, that we can help advance further research for Fragile X-associated conditions.

The 119th Congress was convened on January 3, 2025. At the start of each new Congress, any bills that did not pass in the 118th Congress must be reintroduced to be considered again.
